- **School plan for Continuous Improvement** The school is in the third year of a three year plan, so many of their goals and strategies remain in place with some adjustments as necessary.
 - Living Our Faith This was the first priority, but the school didn't make as much headway as they would have liked with building connections with Annunciation Parish. That goal will remain in place.

A considerable amount of professional development was offered to staff this year and will continue to offer the same in the upcoming year. BDM will be refocusing on their mission and charism, ensuring that the school policies are mission focused and that BDM is a welcoming place for everyone.

- Learning Excellence Most of the school's goals under this priority remain the same, but the focus will be on providing students with meaningful and timely feedback plus on-data analysis so BDM can have more targeted instruction with students.
- Organizational Excellence The key strategy identified by the division here is
 the Truth and Reconciliation Calls to Action. BDM has made great strides, but
 they will keep their current goals in place. They would like to make more
 progress in terms of having members of the FNMI community, which they will
 coordinate through Indigenous Learning Services to visit the classrooms and
 provide meaningful staff professional development.
- Embracing Diversity BDM's goals and strategies in this area are ongoing.
 They will continue to focus on celebrating and valuing the gifts that each
 person brings to our community, but they are doing so in a more targeted
 way.

One of the areas they typically scored poorly in is celebrating diversity. When the survey was written (in November) they only had Orange Shirt Day. They also recognized Black History Month and this year, added Asian History Month. BDM will also be adding more events and activities that highlight many different cultures and backgrounds.

- **School Supply Orders** No School supply orders have been posted, and supplies can be purchased through School Start or at local stores.

Numbers are still fluctuating a little, so these are not the final numbers. Overall, BDM is down six classes and approximately 218 students, which means the Learning Commons will be a library again and classes won't be spaces like the Foods Lab. Also, the maker's spaces will be back again.

The good news is that they have been able to maintain reasonable class sizes, so far, but some difficult staffing decisions were made because BDM (and most schools) are really feeling the pinch with budgets this year and no longer have a very large surplus to draw from. They are also not allowed to run in a deficit so school sizes will remain between 20 and 30 except in younger elementary.
