

## Possible Boundary Changes for BDM

Edmonton Catholic Schools is considering an adjustment to the attendance boundaries for Bishop David Motiuk School for the 2026-2027 school year. Under the proposal, Bishop David Motiuk would become the designated school for students living in the Big Lake area.

This proposed boundary change would help balance enrolment among three schools—Bishop David Motiuk, St. Thomas More, and Annunciation—while better aligning school boundaries with student needs and ongoing community growth. It would also reduce travel time for families in the Big Lake area, as BDM is significantly closer to their neighbourhoods than their current designated schools. Transportation to BDM from the Big Lake communities would be available.

BDM would remain the designated school for Stewart Greens, Webber Greens, Suder Greens, Potter Greens, and Breckenridge Greens. Consultations with families in the Big Lake area are currently underway, and we expect a final decision to be made soon.



## Possible Boundary Changes for BDM

With the opening of St. Josephine Bakhita School, enrolment numbers at BDM are currently below capacity and are projected to decline over the next five years. By welcoming students from the Big Lake area, we anticipate that enrolment numbers would remain consistent with current numbers or slightly increase. As always, we will carefully monitor registrations and adhere closely to ECSD Administrative Procedure 300: Admission of Students, so new registrations will be accepted in the following order:

- 1. Resident\* students in catchment area;
- 2. Resident students residing outside the catchment area;
- 3. Non-resident students residing within the catchment area; and
- 4. Non-resident students residing outside the catchment area.





## PAT Results - 2024-2025

Results are in for the 2024-2025 Provincial Achievement Tests. Students at BDM scored above both the division and provincial averages for the Acceptable Standard in all subjects except Grade 6 Math and scored above both the division and provincial averages for Standard of Excellence in all subjects except Gr 6 & 9 Math. PATs were not written in Gr 6 Science due to implementation of the new curriculum.

It is important that teachers, parents, and students are partners in education. Teachers share assessment information to communicate student progress. Assessment is the process of gathering information about what a student knows, understands, and can do in relation to learning outcomes established by Alberta Education.


All schools in ECSD provide ongoing assessment as a variety of classroom assessments guide teachers with what they need to do next. Teachers at Bishop David Motiuk School enter marks and comments for each assessment directly into the PowerSchool gradebook. For parents, this is like having access to a student report card at any point in time. As well, student-led conferences are offered twice per year. A summary report is posted in January, and the final report card is posted in June.



Student-led conferences are offered twice per year. The division also provides a summary report in January as well as a final report card in June.

Student-led conferences and report cards for this school year are scheduled for:

- Student Led Conferences: November 27, 2025
- Summary Report: January 30, 2026
- Student-Led Conferences: March 19, 2026
- Final Report Card: June 23, 2026

- Snow forts and tunnels can collapse and suffocate a child
- When children are outside, they often do not realize how cold they are becoming
- Bright sun during the winter can cause a sunburn

### What Parents Can Do



- Signs of frost nip are slight pain and whitening of the affected area e.g. tips of the ears turn white. Warm the affected area by breathing on it or warming it with your hands but do not rub. Do not apply snow or water.
- Supervise children when they play outside.
- Choose play areas with warm shelters nearby.
- Provide children with a neck warmer instead of a scarf to prevent strangulation on playground equipment.

### What Kids Can Do

- If you feel pain in your fingers, toes, ears, cheeks, nose or chin, get inside to warm up.
- Dress in layers. If you get too warm take off one layer at a time.
- Wear sunscreen on exposed skin on sunny days.
- Don't put your tongue on cold metal

#### If you can only remember one thing:

 Most of our body heat is lost through our heads, so always wear a hat or toque in cold weather.











# Severe Weather Conditions

When the temperature outside reaches -20 with the windchill or colder, students are kept inside. If they arrive in the morning prior to the start of supervision at 8:20, then they are to enter through the main doors and wait in the foyer until supervision begins. At that time, they will make their way to classrooms. Recess will also be indoors.

Our transportation system has an excellent record for service. However, given the possible extremes of Edmonton weather and the potential for unexpected mechanical difficulties, it is impossible to guarantee buses will run on time or at all. A route can take 50% longer in adverse weather conditions. Parents are advised that if a bus does not arrive within twenty minutes of its scheduled time, they are to assume the bus is not coming. Parents must ensure that their child knows to return home or to a pre-selected location. Parents must then make alternate arrangements to get their child to school.



## Severe Weather Conditions

#### Parents should also ensure that:

- children are supervised at the bus stop
- children have a place to go in the event the bus does not arrive
- children have alternate arrangements for getting to school should the bus not arrive
- children are suitably clothed to withstand weather extremes

Transportation Services normal operational procedures for delayed transportation also apply in severe weather conditions. The Carrier is responsible for notifying the School and the Transportation Services office when a route is running late.

Parents then have access to 3 different resources (by calling either the school, the Transportation Services office, or directly contacting the carrier) to get an update on the status of a particular route.




## **Babysitter Training**

Students are looking forward to Christmas Fun Day, which will feature dances for all grades, classroom activities in PYP, and a visit from Santa for students in K-3.


